West Bengal Ordinance No. II of 2008

THE WEST BENGAL VALUE ADDED TAX (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2008.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the West Bengal Value Added Tax Act, 2003, for the purpose and in the manner hereinafter appearing;

West Ben. Act XXXVII of 2003.

And Whereas the Legislative Assembly of the State of West Bengal is not in session and the Governor is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action;

The Governor is pleased, in exercise of the power conferred by clause (1) of article 213 of the Constitution of India, to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

Short title and

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the West Bengal Value Added Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 2008.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of section 49 of West Ben. Act XXXVII of 2003. 2. In the West Bengal Value Added Tax Act, 2003, in section 49, in subsection (1), in the first proviso, for the words, figures and letters "on or before the 30th day of September, 2008", the words, figures and letters "on or before the 30th day of November, 2008" shall be substituted.
